



Exhibition Guidance – *167 Annual Open Exhibition*

Please read all of the information below to ensure that your entry is valid for submission. Full Terms and Conditions can be downloaded as a separate document from our website.

What is the 167 Annual Open Exhibition?

The Royal West of England Academy holds an Annual Open Exhibition, now in its 167th year. As the name suggests, anyone can enter their work for this mixed discipline show - previous years have included painting, drawing, printmaking, photography, film, sculpture and illustration, and attracted entries from artists across the UK and beyond. A selection panel assesses every entry and last year 634 works by 413 artists made it into the final exhibition. All work is for sale and the exhibition attracts art-lovers and art-buyers from far and wide.

Entry opens on Tuesday 2 July at midday and closes on Tuesday 20 August at 5pm. The exhibition will be open to the public from Sunday 29 September to Sunday 1 December 2019.

A select number of prizes will be awarded with information available on the website.

Submission Guidance

- Artists are encouraged to submit recent work (produced within the last 3 years)
- A maximum of 3 works may be submitted per applicant (4 for Academicians)
- Work cannot have been exhibited before at the RWA
- Work must be for sale

How much does it cost to submit work?

Submission fees are charged per item:

- £20 per item for General Public
- £15 per item for Students
- £15 per item for Friends of the RWA
- £10 per item RWA Artist Network member
- Entry is Free for RWA Academicians

How do I submit work?

- All applicants must apply online using our Online Exhibition Submission System (OESS) which can be accessed via our website.
- Please read the OESS User Guide available to download as a PDF on the RWA website if you are experiencing difficulty registering online.
- Please contact the RWA if you cannot access a computer.
- Please ensure that you have read the Terms and Conditions to ensure that your work fully complies with entry guidelines for this exhibition. Work which is delivered

and does not comply will not be considered for selection and refunds will not be possible.

- Please make sure that you have noted the hand-in, transport and collection dates in advance.

Do I have to submit images of my work online?

- Yes, please include at least one image (maximum of 2) of your work when making your submission via OESS.
- This image may be used for publicity purposes.
- Images should be a JPEG file and should not exceed a maximum size of 3MB. Please use the work title as the file name, and avoid using numbers or symbols.

What happens once I have submitted my work?

The closing date for online submission is Tuesday 20 August at 5pm. After this point no changes can be made to your application. Therefore please ensure that you have submitted all the correct details and paid for your submission by this date. Please note that moving image entries must be received via file transfer or on a memory stick by 5pm on Tuesday 20 August (please see Terms and Conditions for more information). Regional transport must be booked by 5pm on Friday 6 September.

Stage 1: Pre-Selection

Once you have submitted your details via OESS, our selection panel will look at every work submitted online. Works will be either Pre-Selected or Not Selected. Results of the online Pre-Selection will go live on Friday 30 August at 1pm. Artists must log in to their account to view their results. Please note that results are not communicated by email.

Stage 2: Final Selection

If one or more of your works has been Pre-Selected, you must then deliver your work/s to the RWA on the dates highlighted below for physical selection by the panel.

There are two options for delivering work:

- 1) You can bring your work to the RWA between 10am and 5pm on Monday 9 September (Academicians only) or Tuesday 10 and Wednesday 11 September (all other artists).

OR

- 2) You can book to have your work collected from a designated collection point via RWA organised regional transport.

How do I book RWA Transport?

- This must be booked and paid for via a form on the RWA website. You will be sent a link to this if you have one or more works Pre-Selected.
- All transport must be booked and paid for by 5pm, Wednesday 4 September 2019.
- Transport will be available from London, Exeter and Penzance as stated below. **Please note that this year collection from Birmingham is not available.**
- Transport is only available for work which is less than 1.75m² (6ft x 6ft). Sculpture must be under 25kg in weight and be easily handled by one person.
- The cost of the transport is £15 per work per journey.

- When you book please specify whether you require transport one-way or return. If work is sold and return transport has been booked, a refund of £15 per work will be given at the end of the exhibition.
- Booking for return transport will re-open at the end of the exhibition.
- Charges will be incurred for works not collected at stated times.
- The RWA accepts no responsibility for any changes to the schedule. If alterations occur the RWA will inform the artist as soon as possible.
- The RWA does not insure artwork for transport.
- Please note that work should arrive unwrapped unless fragile.
- The RWA is not responsible for wrapping work on return.
- Please see the full Terms and Conditions below for further guidance.

- **Exeter:** Friday 6 September 12.30 - 1.30pm, hand-in work to ArtWorks at Exeter Motorway Service area, (top of Car Park) Off Junction 30 of M5, Exeter
- **London:** Monday 9 September, 12 noon - 4pm, hand-in work to Art Moves of Chelsea, Chelsea Self Storage, Blantyre Street, London, SW10 0EQ.
- **Please note that this year there will not be transport from Birmingham.**

From the RWA:

- **Penzance:** Thursday 5 December, 4.00 – 5.00pm, hand-out of work by ArtWorks in Penzance Harbour Car Park, Penzance
- **Exeter:** Thursday 5 December, 12.00 – 1.00pm, hand-out of work by ArtWorks at Exeter Motorway Service area, (top of Car Park) Off Junction 30 of M5, Exeter
- **London:** Friday 6 December, 12 noon - 4pm, hand-out works from Art Moves of Chelsea at Chelsea Self Storage, Blantyre Street, London, SW10 0EQ
- **Please note that this year there will not be transport to Birmingham.**

Selection and Results

- Selection day will be on Thursday 12 September and results will be available online on Friday 20 September after 1pm.
- Please log-in to OESS where your results will be displayed online.*
- It is the artist's responsibility to check their results. The RWA will not send a results email.
- Please do not call the RWA to check results unless you have difficulty logging on.
- If your work has been accepted you will also receive a link to an invitation to attend the Varnishing Day Lunch on Friday 27 and Private View on Saturday 29 September.

* The RWA reserves the right to alter the hang at any point until the opening, therefore please be aware that although you may hear that your work has been 'Selected' we cannot guarantee that it will make the final hang. If changes are made to the selection after the 20 September we will endeavour to contact the artist by email to communicate this and the status of your work online will change to 'Selected Not Hung'.

How do I collect work at this stage?

If one or more of your works has not been selected at the final selection stage you can collect them on the following dates:

- Tuesday 24 and Wednesday 25, 10am – 4pm
- Friday 11 and Saturday 12 October, 10am – 4pm

If all your submitted works have been unsuccessful at the selection stage, we urge you to collect on one of the above dates, as we are limited with storage space.

If you have some work selected and some work not selected you can opt to collect all work after the exhibition on the following dates:

- Friday 6 and Saturday 7 December, 10am – 4pm
- Thursday 19 and Friday 20 December, 10am – 4pm
- Friday 10 and Saturday 11 January 2020, 10am – 4pm

If you have booked regional transport your work will be returned to the locations listed above.

The RWA has limited storage space therefore we ask that any large / heavy or fragile sculpture that is unsuccessful at the final selection stage is collected by Friday 27 September 2019 (you will be informed if this is necessary when you deliver).

- Final Selection Results Live: 1pm, Friday 20 September
- Varnishing Day Lunch, 2pm-5pm Friday 27 September
- Private View, 3pm-6pm, Saturday 28 October
