A wonderful opportunity to visit beautiful Chipping Campden with its amazing church and High Street. Its Court Barn Museum presents the story of the Arts and Crafts movement and its legacy: how a small town in a beautiful setting became a gathering place for designers and craftspeople of national and international reputation.

The permanent displays focus on nine individuals or workshops including C.R. Ashbee, Katharine Adams, F.L. Griggs, Gordon Russell, Hart Silversmiths and Robert Welch.

A visit to Snowhill Manor is an unforgettable experience. A Tudor house of Cotswold Stone, the appeal of Snowhill is in the interior furnishings. Within the house is a maze of rooms crammed full of the eclectic collections of Charles Paget Wade, who restored the manor and spent a lifetime acquiring items of the highest workmanship and design quality from around the world, in accord with his Arts and Crafts Movement philosophy of the value of the individual artisan.

In addition there is a very beautiful Arts and Crafts style garden composed of distinct garden rooms and the simple home, the Priest's House, where Wade chose to live.
