Art and Culture in The Midlands

28 November – 30 November 2018

Brighten up late autumn with an eye-opening visit to the Midlands. This three-day trip will include visits to beautiful Compton Verney, historic Leicester and Stratford-upon-Avon.

Drive through the beautiful Cotswolds to Compton Verney – a gallery set in gardens designed by Capability Brown. See their spectacular exhibition *Whistler and Nature*.

Then, explore Leicester, which has enjoyed a renaissance since the discovery of Richard III's remains. There will opportunities to visit;

- Leicester New Walk Gallery (free admission) which has an internationally renowned German expressionism collection (c.100 works) plus a significant collection of Picasso Ceramics.
- Attenborough Arts Centre – University of Leicester (contemporary art)
- Leicester's Richard III Visitor Centre
- Leicester Cathedral with Richard III's tomb

The final stop will be Stratford-upon-Avon, with its beautiful historic centre and links to Shakespeare.

Maps and further information on the above places will be available on the coach, which will be available throughout your stay. Coach facilities include semi-reclining seats, air conditioning, on-board WC, and hot drink making equipment.
